An ideal Anchor Youth Ministry Volunteer will:

- Live their faith authentically
- Be flexible
- Have a sense of humor
- Be a relational person
- Bring energy to a group
- Be reliable

Over a given week a Youth Ministry Volunteer will typically:

- Spend an hour planning, preparing, and praying for their ministry.
- Attend Youth Ministry events on Sunday or Wednesday evenings for 2-2.5 hours.
- Lead small group of 6-15 teens, empowering their Christian Faith.
- Assist the Youth Ministry Staff with projects and larger events.

Over a given semester a Youth Ministry Volunteer will typically:

- Give a short talk about their faith.
- Meet with the Director of Youth Ministry or the Coordinator of Middle School Ministry for a check-in.
- Attend a catechist or core team training event.

In addition, all volunteers are required to complete Safe Environment training through Catholic Mutual Group and a background check.
