LESSON 4: HOW DO I KNOW GOD IS REAL?

- For most of your life, has Jesus been Liar, Lunatic or Lord? How about recently? Has your opinion of Jesus ever dramatically changed?
- How has God tried to touch your life in the last year? Keep in mind that sometimes God whispers to us in our joys but shouts to us in our pain.
- If you are comfortable, share your list of who you’d like Jesus to be.

- Why is being a “cradle Catholic” something that has meant a lot to you?
- In what ways has it challenged you?
- What are some roles you look forward to having in the Church after you are Confirmed? Are there any that you can start now?
